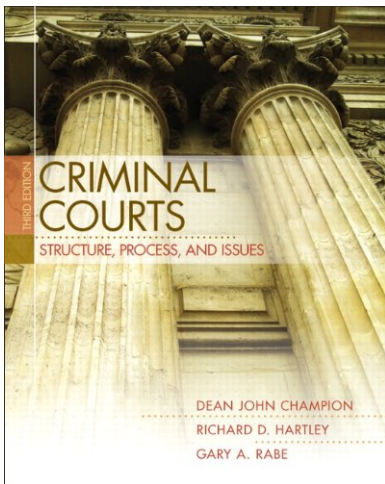

The main components of the criminal justice system include law enforcement, courts, and corrections. The criminal justice process begins when someone commits a crime. Law enforcement officers on patrol can witness a crime directly or be dispatched to respond to a witness's call about a potential crime. When officers arrive on the scene, the second step involves filing a crime report, which includes logging information about the time, location, and details of the incident by speaking with witnesses and/or victims.
