Hence the patterns of roiling, dialectical transformation that have come to define the institutional dynamics of actually In capitalist society, when commodity production develops to a certain stage, strong competitors must achieve the commodity's exchange value with less or no surplus value at first in order to defeat their opponents and kick them out of the market so they can dominate the market and get a higher surplus value. Then they will win back the lost surplus value in the competition with a higher rate of surplus value than before. This reflects the socialist nature in the capitalist regime and is a great progress in the development of capitalist society. In the economy of developed capitalist countries such as Germany, the state-owned capital plus social capital is the major economic base, while in America, France, Britain, and Japan social capital is the main basis of the economy.
