

The American Press

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The American press, on the other hand, can be studied over two periods: the colonial period and the independence. As far as the first period is concerned, the American press was no different from the British press. The first papers were no more than imitations of the London papers in style and size. The weekly Boston News-Letter, published in 1704 by John Campbell, and the New-England Courant by James Franklin was pretty much the same as the London Gazette and other public prints of London. The newspaper's direct ancestor was The Spotlight, which ceased publication in 2001 when its parent organization, Liberty Lobby, was forced into bankruptcy.
