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Gifted Readers: Literature Review. Gifted Readers are Different. Some gifted children, called "globally gifted," score high on all parts of IQ tests. Winner (1996) studied these children and found they do not follow the learning patterns typical of average children. Their book selections included nonfiction titles—even atlases and encyclopedias. While Winner (1996) describes children with language gifts as voracious readers, the literature indicates that their teachers and peers are not. 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Gifted children and learning. A. Internationally, "giftedness" is most frequently determined by a score on a general intelligence test, known as an IQ test, which is above a chosen cutoff point, usually at around the top 2-5%. Children's educational environment contributes to the IQ score and the way intelligence is used. For example, a very close positive relationship was found when children's IQ scores were compared with their home educational provision (Freeman, 2010). However, when teachers or pupils to reflect on their own learning and thinking activities, they increase their pupils' self-regulation.
