Reeves conveys vivid accounts of the changes in the political arena, public policy, popular culture, industry, economy, American Chronicle, which merely adds six years of coverage to the authors' earlier Columbia Chronicles of American Life, 1910-1992 (Columbia Univ., 1995), provides annual summaries. A hybrid mix furnishes almanac-like facts (e.g., yearly sport champions, arts and sciences award winners) and unofficial pop-cultural milestones, selected and presented in an arbitrary and informal way. For instance, advertisements appear to have been chosen because they seemed clever rather than representative of a given year. While it re-creates the sense of each year from 1910 through 1998, it falls short of being useful for anything but trivia. With its bright color graphics and its daily diary format, 20th Century Day by Day immediately appears to be a different sort of book.
