A fourth plane crashes in a field in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. Afghan and UN investigations find that errant fire from a U.S. gunship killed dozens of Afghan civilians in the Shindand District of western Herat Province, drawing condemnation from President Hamid Karzai and bolstering Taliban claims that coalition forces are unable to protect the population. U.S. military officials dispute the death toll in this incident as well as claims that a separate incident in Farah Province left as many as 140 civilians dead. The Afghanistan Analysts Network (AAN) is a non-profit, independent policy research organisation. It aims to bring together the knowledge, experience and drive of a large number of experts to better inform policy and to increase the understanding of Afghan realities. It is driven by engagement and curiosity and is committed to producing independent, high quality and research-based analysis on developments in Afghanistan. The institutional structure of AAN includes a core team of analysts and a network of contributors with expertise in the fields of Afghan politics, governance, rule of law, and Politics. Afghanistan's governing structure has historically consisted of a weak central government unwilling or unable to enforce significant financial or administrative mandates on all of Afghanistan's diverse ethnic communities or on the 80% of Afghans who live in rural areas. Ethnic and rural communities, many of which are divided by mountains and wide expanses, have often looked to local faction leaders for their governance. Tajiks, who speak Dari, are the second-most numerous and second-most powerful community in Afghanistan.

The war in Afghanistan should be studied in relation to political culture, political economy and broader national and regional history. After the formation of the modern nation-state between 1880-1929, Afghanistan has witnessed at least seven major conflicts. The political culture of Afghanistan is an infusion of religious and traditional elements, divided subcultures and mutually reinforcing fissures. Social structures and political culture of Afghanistan differs from region to region, from one nationality to the other, encompassing a heterogeneous ethnicity, religion and language. As Mahmud Mamdani states, Cold War politics and the Islamic Revolution in Iran are two crucial factors that radicalized Islam and militarized the region. How is USA Afghanistan Relations Shaping? What will be Role of India & Pakistan in US Strategy in Afghanistan? We are ready to support peace talks between the Afghan government and the Taliban without any preconditions, and we expect that the international community, first of all the neighbors of Afghanistan, will join us in supporting this peace process, Tillerson said. In his estimation, Washington's new strategy radically differs from previous approaches that were based on artificially created deadlines for accomplishing certain tasks. Intra-Afghan Talks. The U.S.-Taliban agreement envisions the end of the U.S. military effort in Afghanistan, but it does not represent a comprehensive peace agreement among Afghans, which most observers assess is only possible through a negotiated political settlement between the Taliban and the Afghan government. Intra-Afghan talks aimed at achieving such a settlement began in September 2020; the commencement of the long-sought talks represents a major step toward resolving the conflict. Major differences remain in the sides' visions for the future of Afghanistan, including both the structure of the Afghan state and what rights the state recognizes for Afghan citizens, especially women.<sup>15</sup> So the history of US-Afghan relations is not very long and the efforts of the Afghan government for establishing relationship were not cherished up until 1934 and formal diplomatic relations were established in 1942. Afghanistan continued its traditional and preferred role as a buffer state, which prevented it from going into the orbit of any superpower or joining any military alliance. However, the Soviet influence increased and the Soviets provided military training and arms supply to Afghan army. The US adopted flexible approach in its relations with the Soviets, which resulted in increasin
